


Edit Cover Page


Add Narrative

Narrative Heading
Narrative Introduction
Narrative Free Text

2. The user clicks save and then the new narrative page is added to the section

1. If a user wants to add or create a report page they have to click the Add Page Button. This will open a Modal Window in which they are able to enter:

Page Name (not shown on report)
Page Title
Page Narrative

2. The user clicks save and then the new page is added to the section

User Actions

Order Item

In order to order the charts and summaries the user can use arrow controls to move items up and down the report structure.

1. If a user wanted to add Chart Two to the newly created page (New Page) they would click the up arrow two times to get it in to the required page.

2. If the user wanted to remove the chart or summary from the page they just click the down arrow.
