This is used to inform stakeholders and the production team.


CR001: Introduction

There is a "Notes" function, where both customers and Virgin Media Internal users can place notes relating to orders.





Orders In Progress


Orders In Progress is an area for Engage portal users to track the progress of orders. This page is the mian page the user is directed to when the selects Order Schedule from the main portal navigation.


